## 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 Reserve.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions.
- 1.4 Reserve.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the original text will take precedence.
- 1.6 Every person on board shall have the appropriate license.
- 1.7 Reserve.

## 2 ADVERTISING

The regatta will be classified as a Category C Event in accordance with Appendix 1 of the RRS. Competing boats may be required to display advertising of the Event Sponsor, on each side of the boat, on the forward 25% of the hull.

## 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Javelin class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee.
- 3.3 Reserve.

## 4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:

- 4.2 Entries, together with full payment of entry fees, shall arrive to the address shown on the Entry Form, before July 1<sup>st</sup>. Entry fee includes entry to all social events for the skipper and the crew.

## **11 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**11.1** The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A of the RRS will apply. A minimum of five races shall be completed to constitute the European Championship .

## **12 SCORING**

**12.1** Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- 12.2** (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- (b) When 6 ,7, 8 or 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- (c) When 10, 11, or 12 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## **13 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall be marked with RC flag.

## **14 BERTHING**

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the boat park/harbour.

## **17 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

VHF will only be used for safety communication.

## **18 PRIZES**

Helmsman and crew of the winning boat of the championship acquire the title "European Champion" and receive the medals.

Helmsman and crew of the boats that are places second and third acquire also medals.

## **19 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 RRS, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **20 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 640.000 per event or the equivalent.
